

OUR PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

Learning Disabilities Assessments are offered for those children and adolescents who are achieving below their expected academic level in one or more areas. It is important to understand how a child learns best; therefore, strengths as well as weaknesses are measured.

Attention Deficit Evaluations are offered when inattention, poor concentration, impulsivity, disorganization and/or high activity interfere with a young person's learning or peer and family relationships.

Psychological Testing is given when a more thorough understanding of emotional concerns is indicated. These tests help parents, teachers, and therapists better understand a young person's problems and how they impact his or her learning and social relationships.

Accommodation Assessments are specific testing batteries for students who may feel they need additional accommodations for performing up to their potential on standardized assessments such as the I.S.E.E., S.A.T., G.R.E., etc.

Kindergarten Readiness Evaluations are offered to help parents make this important decision whether their youngster is ready to begin school.

Autism Spectrum Disorder Evaluations are conducted using gold-standard measures, including the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS) and Autism Diagnostic Interview-Revised (ADI-R). Diagnostic evaluations follow best practices recommendations for identifying a diagnosis on the autism spectrum. In addition to the diagnostic evaluation, we offer a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary assessment including speech and language, occupational therapy and psycho-educational testing to further profile your child's strengths and challenges in these areas.

Career Testing and Planning assesses a young person's academic abilities, cognitive strengths and self-reported interests in order to explore potential career choices.

Neurofeedback is an alternative treatment program for children and adolescents with AD/HD.
